

Construction Quiz guidelines

1. Time and place

- 1.1. The competition will take place on the **20th of March, 2024** at **12.30 to 13.30**.
- 1.2. Tallinn University of Technology assembly hall, Ehitajate tee 5, Tallinn.

2. Aim of the competition

- 2.1. To popularise the civil engineer profession.
- 2.2. To offer an opportunity for university and gymnasium students to test one's knowledge and experience in the field of construction and, thus, add value to their studies.

3. Task and system of the competition

- 3.1. The quiz will be conducted using the Kahoot! platform.
- 3.2. Different questions in the field of construction must be answered at the competition.

4. Competitors

- 4.1. Teams consisting of **1-3 members** of university and/or gymnasium students are allowed to partake in the competition.
- 4.2. Participation is free of charge.
- 4.3. There is no age cap in the competition.
- 4.4. Participation in the competition is at your own risk. The organiser is not responsible for any accidents or their consequences.

5. Registration

- 5.1. Registration to the competition is done electronically via the BuildIT website.
- 5.2. In the case of available slots, registration is also available on the spot, just before the competition.
- 5.3. By registering, participants consent to the use of photos and filming material taken of them during the event for marketing purposes.

6. Ranking determination

- 6.1. Ranking is determined by the acquired points.
- 6.2. Points are formed based on the speed and correctness of responses.

7. Prizes

- 7.1. Teams that achieve I-III places are awarded by the organiser.
- 7.2. The best team consisting only of gymnasium students will receive a special prize.
